POOL RULES - Please help us maintain a high caliber event by following facility rules.

- No coolers or helium balloons in the building.
- No glass on deck.
- No street shoes on deck. Shoes must be worn upstairs in concourse.
- No food on deck.
- Athletes, coaches and spectators are restricted to the aquatic side of the facility.
- Please clean up team area at the end of each session.
- Shaving is prohibited in the facility.

ENTRANCE - South gallery stair well. Teams and officials will be given credentials to access deck. If athlete credentials are lost, please check-in in the concourse to receive a stamp.

SPECTATOR and TEAM SEATING - The facility doesn't allow demarcation of seats in the gallery. Seats should not be saved. Facility personnel will hang team banners in appropriate areas as space allows. Inquire in the aquatic office. No team seating will be allowed around the dive well area.

FACILITY DAMAGE - Facility damage will be charged back to the team.

EVACUATION - There is an emergency page system. Three emergency exits are located at the west end (scoreboard end) of the 50-meter pool and dive well. Do not use these doors except in the event of an emergency. The doors are alarmed. The lifeguard emergency signal is 2 whistle blasts. Please direct swimmers to exit the pool immediately if you here this signal.

ACCIDENT/INCIDENTS - For any injury sustained at the aquatic center, Miami University will need to fill out an accident report. Lifeguards will handle all in-water emergencies as well as minor injuries. EMS will be called in the event of serious injury. Emergency response time is approximately 5 minutes.

HOSPITAL - McCullough-Hyde Hospital is located at 110 N Poplar Street, 1 mile away and has on-call emergency medical service 24 hrs/day. Emergency response time is approximately 5 minutes. **The number is 523-2111.**

PHONE - A courtesy phone is located in the Aquatic Lobby. To dial locally off campus - dial "88" first. To make a credit card call - dial "8-1-800-###-####".

PARKING - The Campus Ave and the Oak St. lots are reserved for Recreational Sport Center Members. There is additional parking 1 block north/west on Campus Avenue at the Health Center and the Campus Avenue Building available all day Fri, Sat and Sun. **Parking is also available in the parking garage located on Campus Ave at the rate of \$.50 per hour.** You will be ticketed if you are illegally parked (on grass, in yellow zone, hydrant, etc). If you receive a parking ticket mistakenly for an unregistered vehicle, please sign it and give it to an Aquatic Director/Assistant Director. **PLEASE NOTE:** We cannot void tickets issued by the City of Oxford for violations such as parking in a handicapped space, fire lane, yellow lines, etc. You **MUST** pay city street meters...we have no control over those tickets.

PERSONAL WORKOUTS - Coaches, athletes and spectators may use the entire Recreational Sport Center for a reduced \$6/day fee. Purchase pass at the Membership/Pro shop in the concourse. **BUILDING HOURS FOR WORKOUTS OR POOL**
